Membership is open to anyone interested in yachting and boating generally on application, regardless of sex, age, disability, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation, religion or other beliefs.

What we offer

A full year-round programme of sailing and social events.

Friendly help and advice from many other boat-owners, some of whom have sailed the Atlantic, the Baltic, the Med and the North Sea, while others are content to potter in the Swale and Medway.

Two Waiting Moorings out in The Swale off Harty, provided free for use by members waiting for the tide, or to spend an overnight stay if you don't plan to venture far.

A Licensed Bar is open every Sunday from midday until 3pm, with sandwiches or light snacks usually available, and run by members. Bar prices are competitive because there are no staff to pay and the profits help keep subscriptions low!

Membership is respected by other RYA-affiliated yacht clubs and will ensure a warm welcome wherever you go.

Our members come from all walks of life, ranging from a few professional seamen to weekend boaters with modern yachts, traditional craft, motor cruisers, fishing boats and dinghies - or no boat at all.

Some will get satisfaction from an accurate landfall after a hard offshore sail, others revel in landing a decent cod off the Pollard or a quiet drink in a peaceful creek listening to wildlife.

HCC is a very relaxed and informal club but we have rules and observe nautical traditions. From day to day the club is run by an annually-elected committee, led by the Commodore (the traditional post of chairman of a yacht club).

Once approved by the committee, you receive a membership card with programme and are free to use the club and its facilities.
